Conditions of Play

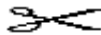
10.30am start One Game x 18 ends on Grass. One game x 18 ends on Carpet.

What puzzles us is, why would you bother to borrow "£5,000"?

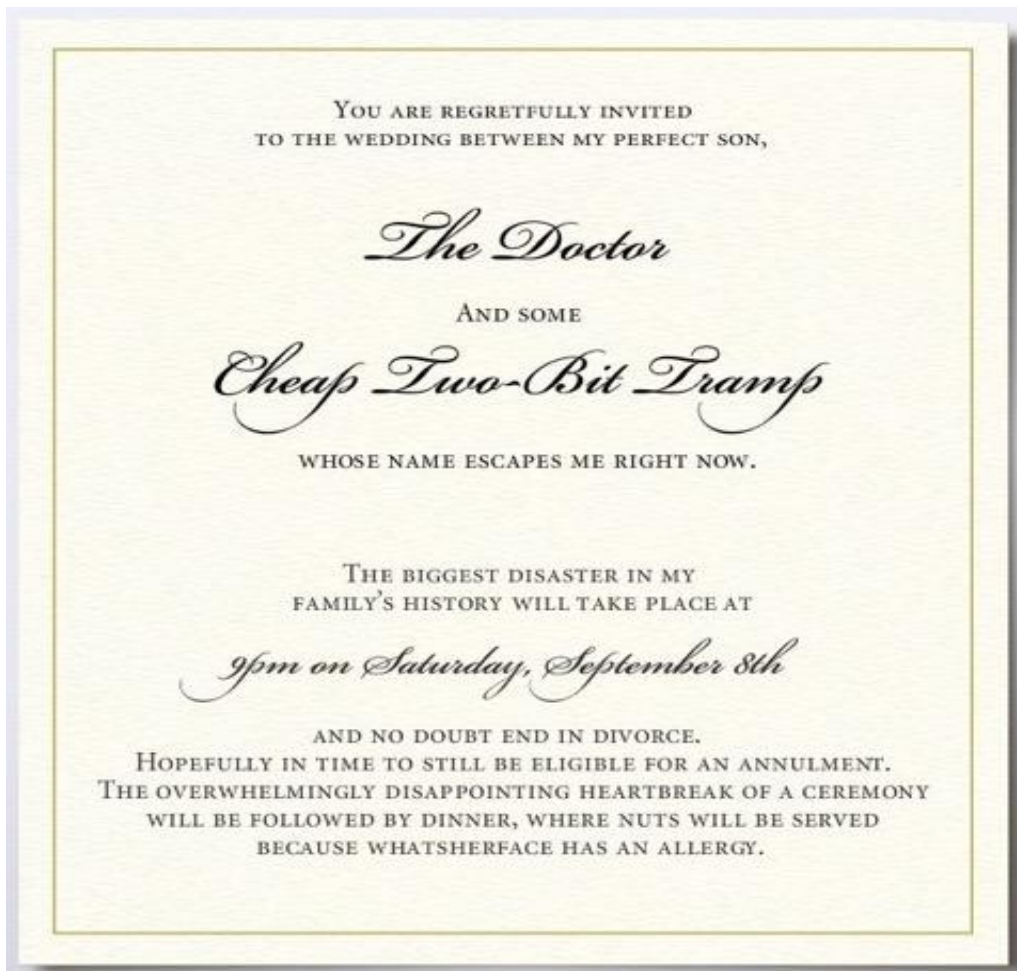
The Yorkshireman replies: "Where else in Leeds can I park my car for two weeks for only £15.41 & expect it to be there when I return"

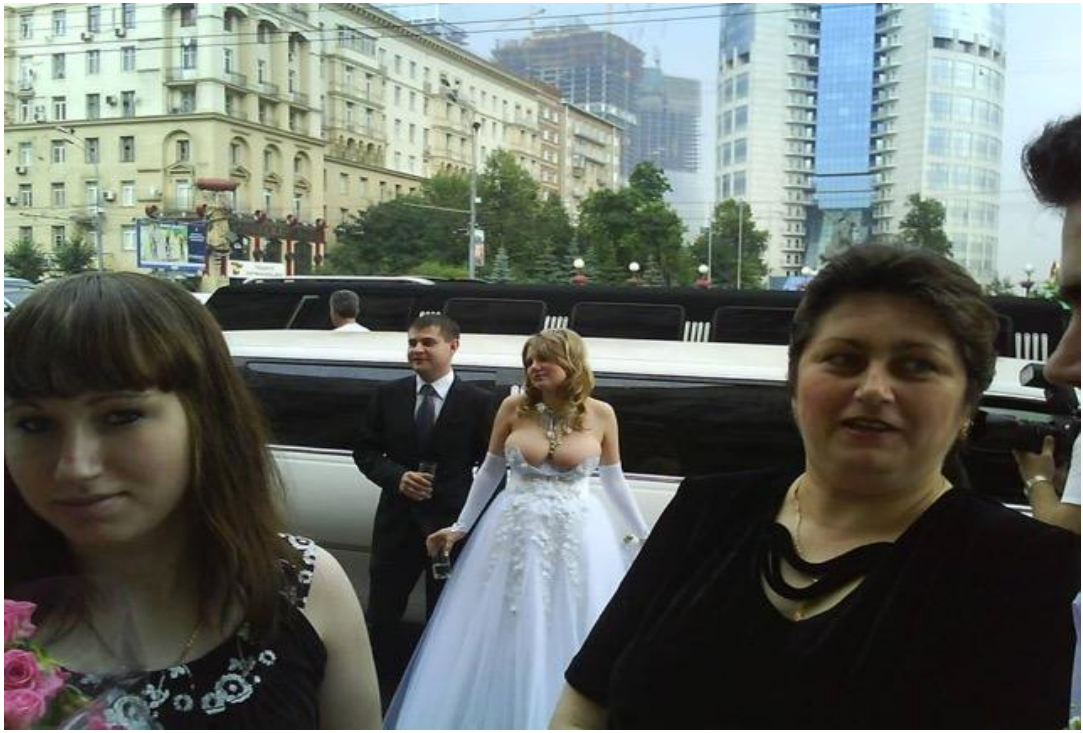
