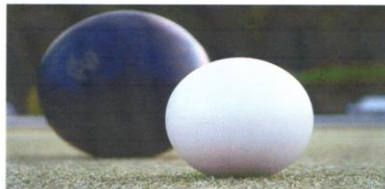

"I'm really worried about my wife" a man told his doctor.

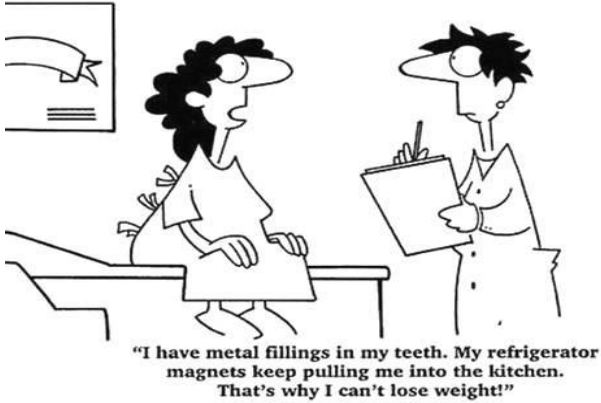
"I think she may need psychiatric treatment"

"Why, what seems to be the problem?" the doctor asked.

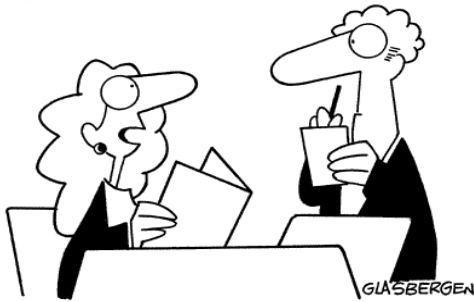

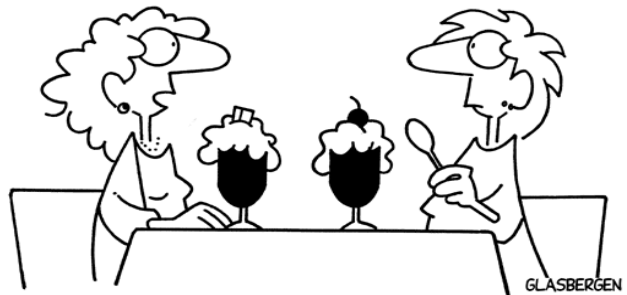
