2ND DEFIBRILLATOR NOW AVAILABLE IN THE BOWLS SHED

Our Club's leading Safety Program is recognised not only among Bowling Clubs, but among Sports Clubs generally. We can be very proud of our Safety standards. Just in the past 2 weeks, unfortunately, the Ambulance and Hatzolah were called out 3 times. In all instances our attention was prompt and everyone concerned was well attended to, and recovered well.

Two were visitors and one Armadale member. Thanks to all the Safety Officers and members who responded very professionally to meet our standards.

We consider and update our needs and training very regularly.

With 4 Doctors in our team and many trained members we are remarkably well equipped.

Despite our high standards, the Club has now purchased a SECOND DEFIBRILLATOR; to HAVE ACCESS TO AED'S BOTH INDOORS AND OUTDOORS. Even in very large Sporting Clubs this is very unusual. Our decision was taken in particular to provide safety when the Clubhouse is locked.

WHERE IS IT; WHAT TO DO

In the Bowls Shed. All Members have access to this room and for the most part during bowls (practice, pennant, social bowls) it is kept open. So it is the most accessible and secure location.

Both machines are fully automated and instruct you on what to do. Please do not be afraid to access it if you are the only person around to help someone else; even if you are not a trained officer.

Use it if a person appears not to be breathing.

WHAT NOT TO DO.

Please do not OPEN THE BOX JUST TO HAVE A LOOK AT IT.

It is equipped with a very loud siren. That is intentional; to assist you attract the attention of others.

It will go off once you close it.

Robin joined a composite team with outside clubs.

SKIPPER SCHOOL BY ROD HUDDLE(HEAD COACH)

The skipper is a key player who directs their team's play. The skipper must be a team player but in control. The best skippers lead by example, let their bowls do the talking and can remain calm under pressure.

1. Be confident and skilled to be able to draw to save.
2. Assess the green carefully to determine how each hand plays.
3. Encourage your team members and other players in your side. Be vocal with praise & quiet with advice.
4. The Skip leads the team and implements the Game Plan
5. Give clear instructions to your players, explain the shot required and the ideal weight. Show where you want the bowl to finish.
6. Motivate by setting a good example. Display good body language and control any displeasure.
7. Be cool under pressure. Relax and retain your composure.
8. Apply good decision making and risk analysis. Make smart shot selection to create opportunities and minimize loss. Skips should inspect the head before drives
9. Skippers must be able to draw around bowls to add a counter or save. They need all the shots to convert, add shots, play position or kill the end.
10. Be patient and build a head. Create a target before wasting drives.
11. Play positive into head when down & play carefully when holding shot. Be happy with 1 or 2 shots an end. Don't be too greedy.
12. Change the lead's hand if they are getting beaten. Ask your third or second to the head to clarify any uncertainty.
13. Always acknowledge good bowls and good attempts but avoid praising poor bowls as a good try.

SKIPPING AND TEAM PLAY NOTES BY HUNNY LIPSON, COACH.

SKIPPING TIPS

1. Guide building the head
2. Ensure you have an insurance bowl
3. Assess strength and weaknesses of opposition
4. Choose the length of the end
5. Choice of shot to be played
6. Decide on attacking or defensive play
7. Analysis of playing the shot
8. Ask players to look at head if uncertain
9. Keep main score board in mind when playing shots with risk.
10. Encourage team harmony

A SKIP SHOULD HAVE;

1. Leadership qualities
2. Awareness of changing conditions
3. Self assurance and confidence
4. Awareness of their player's strength and weaknesses
5. Excellent temperament
6. A positive reaction to their player's anxiety, help them
7. A positive attitude to the game
8. Mental toughness
9. Good body language
10. Carefully explain shots to be played
11. Self control and skills in psychology

TEAM PLAY

1. All team members have the responsibility to motivate and encourage each other
2. Work on team goals not individual goals
3. Praise is the single greatest incentive to good play
4. Act and look confident with yourself and your team
