The doctor said, 'I didn't say that. I said, 'You've got a heart murmur; be careful.'

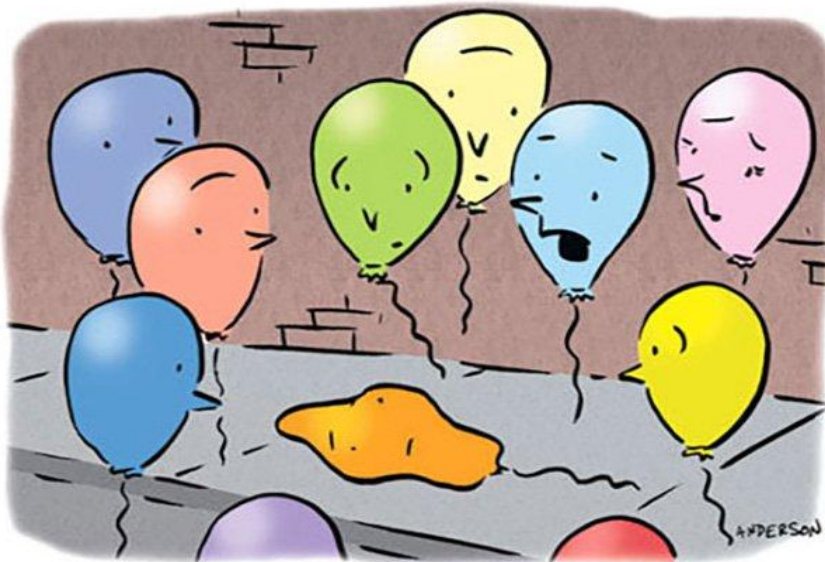

The waitress asked kindly, 'Crushed nuts?'

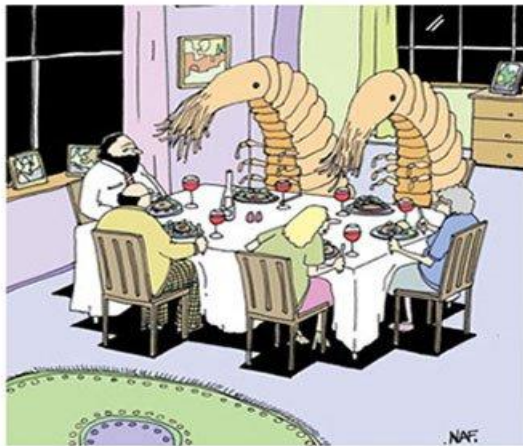
